




PathConnect ICD-10 Functionality

In preparation for the October 1st, 2015 go-live of ICD-10, PathGroup has successfully added new features and enhancements to our existing PathConnect application to ensure a smooth transition for all users. As with ICD-9, PathConnect now has the capability to accept ICD-10 diagnostic coding within an electronic lab order. In addition, PathConnect's "Search Diagnosis Code Directory" feature has been enhanced to include all ICD-9 and ICD-10 query options for the user in a single directory screen.

PathConnect ICD-9 to ICD-10 Crosswalk Feature

The transition from ICD-9 to ICD-10 produced an increase of around 13,000 ICD-9 codes to around 68,000 codes for ICD-10. Clients are expected to submit a valid ICD-10 code for all lab orders submitted to PathGroup beginning October 1st, 2015. In an effort to provide tools to help our clients with understanding the correlation of ICD-9 codes to the vast increase of ICD-10, we have built a Diagnosis Code Crosswalk tool, giving users the ability to enter a previously used ICD-9 diagnosis code, and view the correlating code or codes in the new ICD-10 system for submission. Below are examples of the Crosswalk feature, and the different scenarios a user may encounter when attempting to find a newly available ICD-10 code, by utilizing a previously known ICD-9 entry.


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PathConnect ICD-9 to ICD-10 Crosswalk Search Examples

1 to 1 Exact Coding Match

This query provides the user with a search result that is an exact match from the previously used ICD-9 code, to the new ICD-10 diagnosis option.


- ICD-9 code of 244.9 (Hypothyroidism, Unspecified) correlates to an exact ICD-10 code match of E03.9 (Hypothyroidism, Unspecified)




1 to 1 Approximate Coding Match

This query provides the user with a search result that is approximate to the previously used ICD-9 code, and provides them with the option to use the selected code. There is also a new "Print" feature which allows the user to print the approximate match screen to provide the findings to the physician for verification of the code search.

V70.0 (Routine Medical Exam) correlates to an Approximate ICD-10 Diagnosis Match for
 Z00.0 (Encounter for general adult medical examination without abnormal findings)








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1 to 2 or More Approximate Coding Matches


This query returns a multiple search result that is approximate to the previously used ICD-9 code, giving the user the ability to view the multiple ICD-10 search result options that are considered "approximate" to the previous ICD-9 code. The user again has the ability to "Print" the approximate match screen to provide the findings to the physician for verification of the code search.

V22.1 (Supervision OT Normal Pregnancy) correlates to 2 approximate diagnosis matches for ICD-10 Z34.80 (Encounter for supervision of other normal pregnancy, unspecified trimester) OR Z34.90 (Encounter for supervision of normal pregnancy, unspecified, unspecified trimester)



Expanded Pap Diagnosis Codes

ICD-10 implementation has released Expanded Pap Diagnosis Codes for Pap testing. Providers will need to indicate the specific Routine, High Risk, or Diagnostic coding option, as listed in PathConnect.
